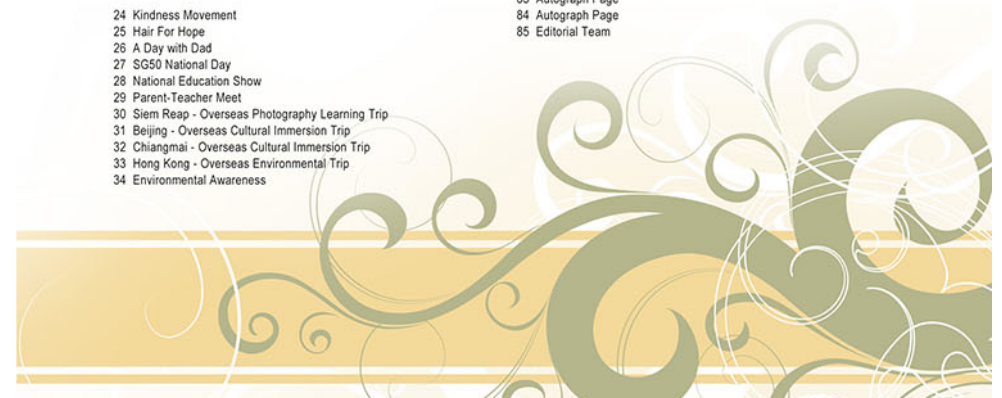

Writing Culture @ Edgefield

At Edgefield Primary, the English Language (EL) programmes are designed to make "Every child an Author, a Story Teller and a Confident Speaker".

The EL Department strives to ignite a spark towards writing. Primary One pupils experienced the 4 'C's (curiosity, collaboration, connection and confidence) in the process of writing and publishing their class story book. Through this, pupils learn that every child can be an author and that writing can be enjoyable and meaningful.

The 3-day English Language Week on 8 July 2015 complements the school's EL curriculum. Our pupils came to school dressed as book characters, superheroes, fairy-tale characters and famous people. Teachers who were also supportive came in the likes of Steve Jobs, Snow White, Batman and Robin. Over the three days, pupils participated in activities such as Kamishibai (Japanese art of storytelling) carried out by our teachers and the English Language Ambassadors.



DEBATES

The Wits & Words Inter-school Debate Championship

The Wits & Words Inter-school Debate Championship is a national primary school debating competition jointly organised by the Gifted Education Branch with Debate Association Singapore and Nanyang Girls' High School. This competition focuses on building the oral competencies of talented pupils.

After about 3 months of intense competition, our debaters emerged victorious, clinching 3rd position in the 2nd Division of Wits and Words Inter-School Debate Championship 2015. In addition, Sanjay Adhith was awarded the best speaker in the quarter-final round and Shivanshu Pathania, was awarded the best speaker in the 3rd-4th placing competition. To put a feather in the cap, Team Edgefield has emerged 2nd Overall in the North Zone-2nd Division of Wits and Words 2015, and our debater, Roma Shrikant Joshi, was also awarded the Good Speaker Award for being in the top 10 Best Speakers!

The Raffles Institution Inter-Primary School Debate

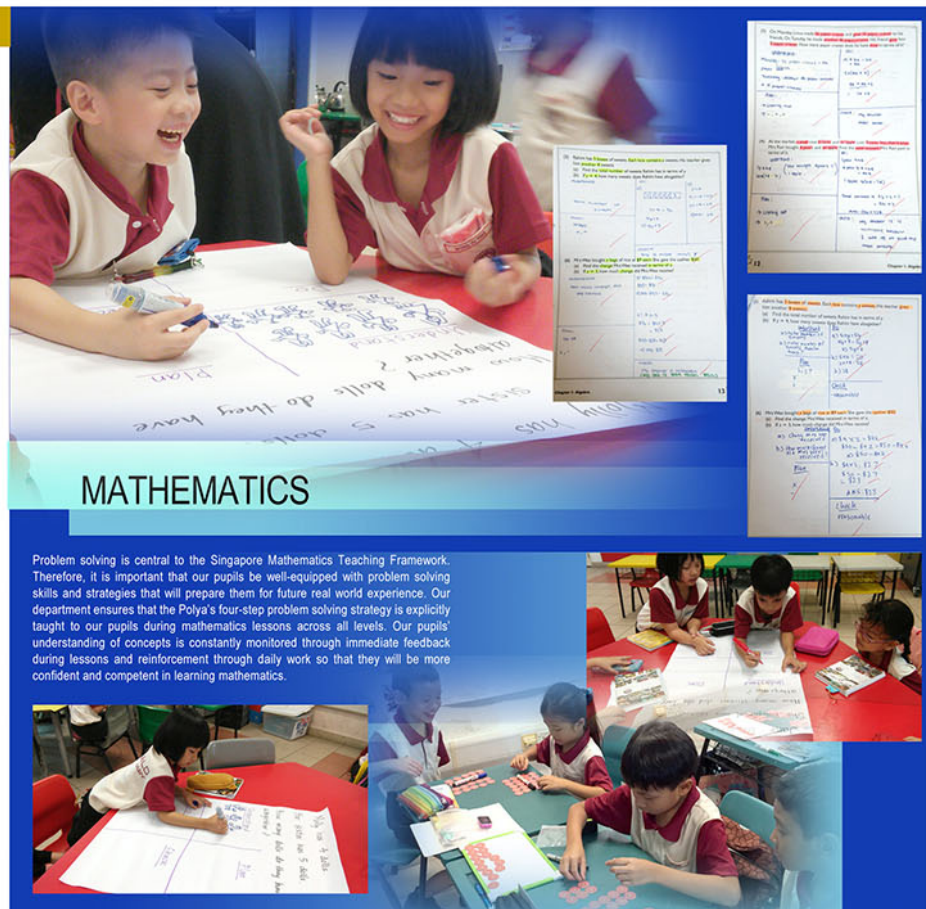

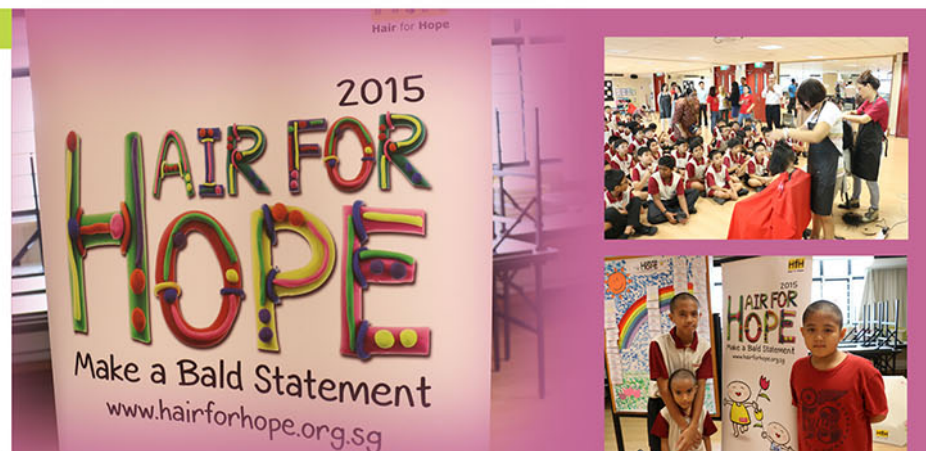
Some of the activities implemented were:

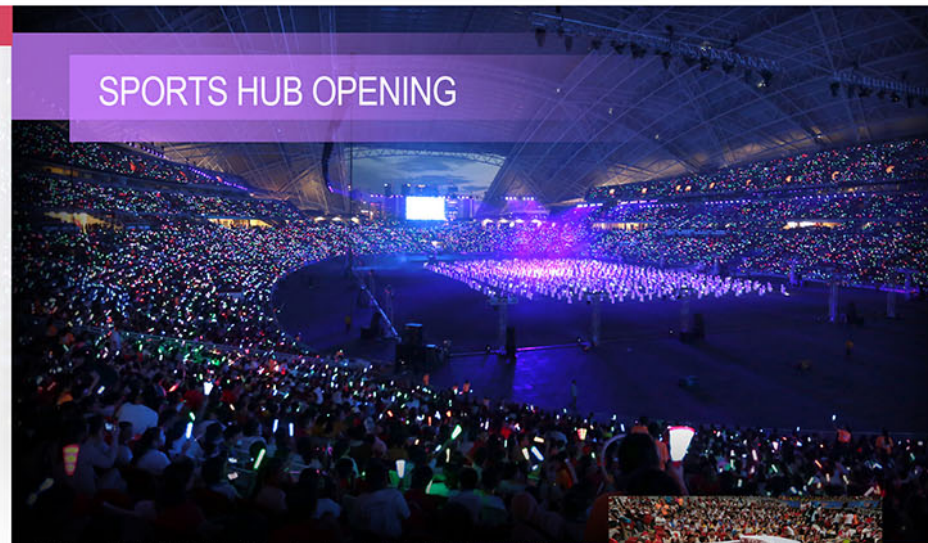

Here's to many more years of footballing success, Edgefield!

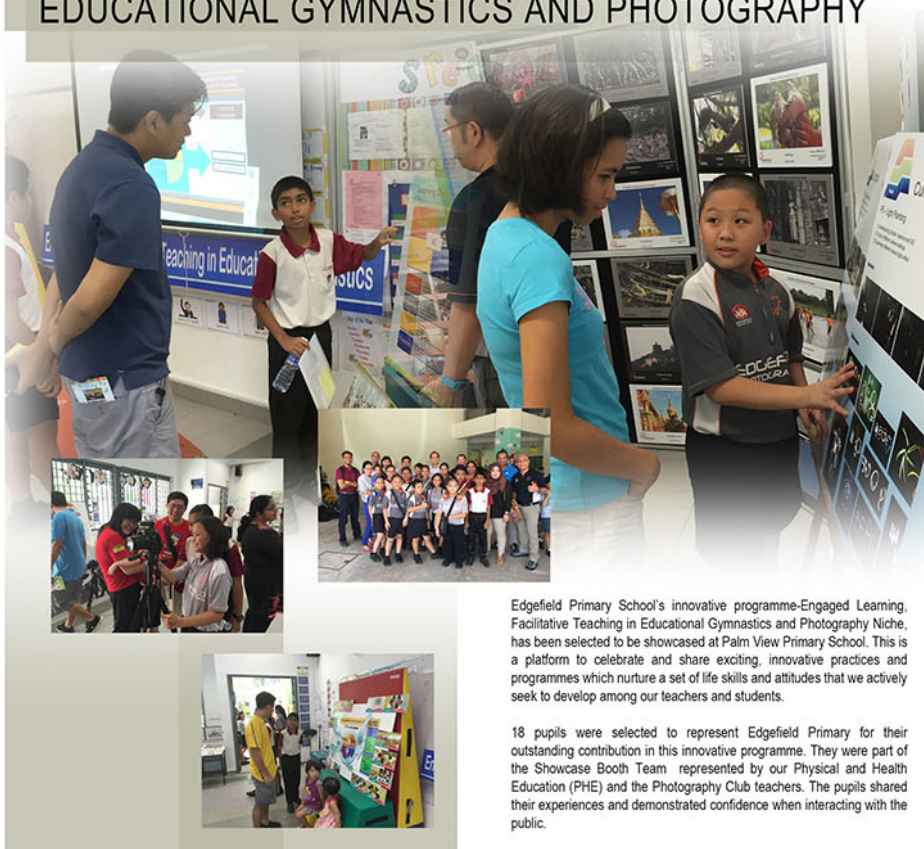


P4 ADVENTURE CAMP
